Parrott Construction is committed to ensuring that it:

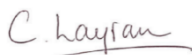
- Complies with all compliance obligations, where these relate to our environmental aspects and ISO 14001:2015.
- Provides employees and others with the resources needed for the EMS, including support, direction and encouragement to fulfil the requirements, commensurate with their role.
- Strives to integrate the EMS into all business processes.
- Considers the environmental lifecycle of products, prevents pollution and meets other specific relevant commitment(s).
- Considers and addresses the needs of relevant parties in respect of the effect of climate change on its operations and local environment
- Manages and minimises its wastes by reducing its waste generation and by segregating, re-using and recycling waste, where economically and operationally feasible.
- Ensures that the environment is considered in the procurement of goods and services.
- Gives appropriate consideration for the environment in the goods and services it provides to customers.
- Uses and monitors the use of energy, water, materials and other natural resources as effectively as possible, giving particular regard to the lifecycle, and long-term sustainability of consumable items.
- Manages and seeks to reduce the carbon emissions of plant, machinery and vehicles by way of alternative methods of motive and operational power, including electric and potentially hydrogen power, vehicle sharing, journey planning, local employment and use of local suppliers, where practicable to do so.
- Develops, maintains and regularly reviews action plans for the further reduction of carbon emissions and to aim for carbon neutral operations up to 2030
- Manages the transport of both labour and materials to and from work-sites to minimise travel and cut carbon emissions to a practicable minimum
- Ensures that the environment and carbon emissions are considered in the procurement of goods and services and seeks to minimise the transport of these to sites.

The EMS will be monitored, measured, evaluated and enhanced regularly with regular reporting and communication of its status and effectiveness at all levels.
